Enlarge these labels. Glue each onto a separate piece of white card stock or drawing paper. Glue down samples of colors mixed in the range you want to see at each station. Use the left-over mixing samples from the color wheel lesson or mix new ones. Make many so the students see the possibilities. Laminate and use as the visual directions for students as they work at a station.

For six stations:

1 YELLOW TO ORANGE

MAKE SHEETS OF PURE YELLOW BEFORE MIXING

2 RED ORANGE TO RED

3 MAGENTA TO VIOLET

MAKE SHEETS OF PURE MAGENTA BEFORE MIXING

4 BLUE VIOLET TO BLUE

5 CYAN, BLUE-GREENS & DARK GREENS

MAKE SHEETS OF PURE CYAN BEFORE MIXING

6. GREEN TO YELLOW GREEN

- 1 YELLOW ONLY. NO MIXING.**
- 2 YELLOW ORANGE TO ORANGE**
- 3 RED ORANGE TO RED**
- 4 MAGENTA ONLY. NO MIXING.**
- 5 RED VIOLET TO VIOLET**
- 6 BLUE VIOLET TO BLUE**
- 7 CYAN ONLY. NO MIXING.**
- 8 BLUE GREEN TO DARK GREEN**
- 9 YELLOW GREEN TO MEDIUM GREEN**
